Certificate to Board

The Danish government has imposed control of all Danish borders effective Saturday 14 March 2020 at 12:00 noon. There are a number of countries from where entry into Denmark is allowed. Please refer to the Danish Police's webpage for a complete list of open countries as regards entry into Denmark: <https://politi.dk/en/coronavirus-in-denmark/travelling-in-or-out-of-denmark/is-my-country-open-or-banned>

Persons wishing to enter Denmark must expect to be rejected entry at the Danish borders, including in Danish airports, unless they are residents of these countries or have a worthy purpose for entering.

The Danish Police is the correct authority that identifies what is a worthy purpose for entering Denmark. Please refer to the Danish Police's webpage for a complete list of worthy purposes and requirements: <https://politi.dk/en/coronavirus-in-denmark/travelling-in-or-out-of-denmark/persons-resident-in-banned-countries>

Please note that the Danish authorities, such as the Danish Embassies, do not issue any pre-approvals for entering Denmark. Instead, we refer to the information about the current restrictions listed on the website of the Danish Police.
